# B.O.B. Tour - Tournament Rules

## (Scratch Division)

**1. Eligibility:** Open to all male and female scratch bowlers over the age of 18 with the following exceptions: National Exempt Touring PBA members, PBA National "members" who have participated in the PBA in the past 3 years are not eligible. If you only participated as a guest you are eligible. Regional PBA members are eligible. No average verification is required. No membership fees are required. This is not a sanctioned event. All players must have valid identification w/photo for verification purposes, i.e., license, identification card, etc.

**2.** Fifty bowlers in the finals in each division will be determined by 3-game qualifying rounds. If there is a tie for the fifth qualifying position, the bowler with the highest game will advance to the finals. If there is still a tie, there will be a three frame sudden death roll-off.

**3.** Top 50 finals competition will consist of 5 games. A random drawing will determine lane assignments. All 50 finalists will compete for the purse in the Bowler Potgame Area at least one time. The bowler with the highest game with handicap in the BPA wins the purse. Bowlers in 2<sup>nd</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> place in the Bowler Potgame area win sponsor contributions.

**Tie Games:** If more than one bowler has the same score during games 1-4 for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> or 10<sup>th</sup>, the bowlers will rotate to the next set of lanes and continue to compete against each other during the next game to determine the winner. The bowler with the highest next game will be the winner (lowest game for 10<sup>th</sup>). If there is still a tie, the bowler with the highest series at that point will win (10<sup>th</sup> place – lowest series). If there's still a tie, a coin toss will determine the winner.

**If bowlers tie in game #5, the bowler with the highest series wins (10<sup>th</sup> place –lowest series). If there's still a tie, the bowler with the most strikes wins (10<sup>th</sup> least amount of strikes). If there's still a tie, the bowler with the most spares will win. (10<sup>th</sup> least spares). If there's still a tie, the bowler with the least open frames will win (10<sup>th</sup> – most open frames). If there's still a tie, a coin toss will determine the winner.**

**4. Regarding ties and the spectator Pickplayer drawing:** All tickets will advance, i.e., if Bowler # 2 and Bowler # 9 both had a 223, spectator tickets for bowlers 2 and 9 will advance to the random drawing to win Free bowling gear from our sponsors

**5.** The bowler with the highest total score for the 6 games during Sunday's finals will win the tournament. If there is a tie for first place, each bowler will play one more game to determine the winner.

**6.** Bowlers will receive 10 minutes of practice prior To the beginning of all squads. The 10 bowlers who compete in the position round (game 6) will receive two practice balls on each lane.

**7.** If a bowler is absent or unable to finish they will be scratched and there will be no replacement. A bowler arriving late will receive a score of zero for all frames missed

**8.** Only one re-rack per game will be allowed.

**9.** All bowlers must wear suitable attire. M/FM may wear shorts or slacks.

We would appreciate it if bowlers have their name on the back of their shirt during competition to make it easier for spectators to select players to win free bowling gear, but it's NOT required.

**10.** Players preparing to step on the approach and deliver a ball shall have the following rights and obligations:

**A.** Players shall be ready to bowl when it is their turn.

**B.** Players will abide by a one-pair courtesy. For example: If you are bowling on lane 3, make sure you don't bowl at the same time another bowler is bowling on lanes 1&2 or lanes 3&4.

**11.** Equipment must meet all USBC (WIBC/ABC) requirements for surface hardness, weight, balance, and size/number of holes. Balls will not be checked; however, all players may have their equipment checked at any time. Non-compliance or use of illegal equipment will result in disqualification and forfeit of entry fee. Plugged equipment may be used.

**12.** Each bowler is responsible for verification of his/her scores and must initial each score and sign their recap or the score will not count. Any scoring corrections must be made prior to signing the recap forms. Questionable errors will be resolved by the Tournament Director. All protests involving eligibility or rules will be resolved by the Tournament Director.

**13.** Bowlers must behave responsibly at all times. Disorderly conduct may result in disqualification and forfeiture of entry fees. The Tournament Director has the right to modify rules at any time.

Even though this event is not USBC sanctioned at this time, USBC rules may be used (pending their approval) to resolve unforeseen situations that may occur.

**14.** Sponsor contributions subject to change.

**15. RE: Bowler pictures.** All bowlers who participate in the tournament agree to grant BMC Promotions non-exclusive rights to post their photos on the web site and allow us to use them for promotional purposes and for our presentation to production companies .
